Dear Full Name,

The purpose of this letter is to notify you of a breach of some personal information that you disclosed [REDACTED] in connection with a loan transaction. While this personal information was taken from [REDACTED] computer systems, we believe that it has been contained, that WJB has retrieved the information, and that such information was scrubbed from the offending parties' systems.

During late July and early August [REDACTED], three of [REDACTED]'s former loan officers and one assistant, [REDACTED] in concert with another mortgage company, [REDACTED] Mortgage, Inc. ("RPM") took files from [REDACTED] computer systems, including some of your personal data while they were still employed with [REDACTED]. Specifically, information relating to your income, marital status, and loan information was removed from [REDACTED] systems and uploaded onto [REDACTED]'s internal computer systems. At this time, it is unclear whether or not [REDACTED] used this information, but [REDACTED] has not uncovered evidence that the information was disseminated to the public at large.

After discovering the [REDACTED] breach, [REDACTED] obtained a court order requiring the return of all private customer information to [REDACTED], prohibiting the defendants from sending that information to others, and requiring that the defendants destroy all copies of the information in their possession. WJB was only recently able to confirm that your personal data was involved in this concerning incident.

[REDACTED] will provide you with a identity theft protection service related to fraud alert on your behalf. A fraud alert will notify you that someone may be using your information improperly. Please contact us if you would like to accept this offer.
